

RMC member exhibition at Norlin Library, University Colorado Boulder

GBW/RMC members are invited to exhibit book works at Norlin Library during the entire summer "Book Craft" event, May 19th through September 8th. This is a non-juried, open exhibition. Our goal is to feature as many members as possible to a diverse CU Boulder community, in an effort to raise awareness of fine art and craft of bookbinding.

Eligible are any book works done since 2000 — fine binding, sculptural, art object, altered and broadside (calligraphy/paper/fine letter press). Members may submit up to two pieces. Depending on the number of entries and space available, one or both may be accepted. We will accept the first 40 pieces, which is based on the available display space (space for oversized items are limited), but the final entry number may vary slightly. You may contact Sammy Lee at sammy@studiosmlk.com, prior to entry submission, to ensure availability for display.

Fees:

A \$15 entry fee must accompany each entry. Checks will be made out to Guild of Bookworkers and sent to the above address. Local drop off can be arranged; please email sammy@studiosmlk.com. If an entry is mailed, please include a return label with sufficient postage for return.

Additionally, please include a separate check, made out to Guild of Bookworkers, to cover the shipping insurance cost for return.

Entry fee will be returned, if space cannot accommodate the work.

Insurance:

Artwork will be displayed in secure cases and will be fully insured for its value against theft or total damage while on premises. Entrants are responsible for shipping insurance both ways.

Catalog:

An online catalog will be posted on our RMC facebook. Printed catalog may be available online for purchase. We will announce more on this separately. A printed exhibit list will be available at each display area. The catalog will be made from supplied digital images and artist information.
